Online Re-admission for UG (2nd & 3rd Year) and PG (2nd Year) Students under SAMS for the Academic Session 2026-27

In pursuance of the Guidelines issued by the Higher Education Department, Government of Odisha vide no. 41499/HE dt. 01-08-2026 regarding online re-admission through the SAMS Portal, all eligible students of UG 2nd Year, UG 3rd Year and PG 2nd Year (Regular & SFC) admitted through SAMS are hereby informed to complete their online re-admission from 05.08.2026 (04:00 PM) to 31.08.2026 (11:45 PM). Students are instructed to comply with the following:

1. Log in to the SAMS Portal using your existing User ID and Password and submit the online re-admission request.
2. After login, carefully verify the particulars displayed on the portal, including:
 - Name of Institution
 - Course
 - Admitted Subject
 - Mode of Programme
 - Academic Year
 - Previous Admission Details
3. Before submitting the re-admission request, each student shall:
 - Declare whether he/she has maintained **minimum 75% classroom attendance** during the previous academic session.
 - Provide online consent to the attendance requirement and all other terms and conditions of the "Gyanodaya" Scheme.
4. Students are advised to furnish correct information only. Any incorrect declaration regarding attendance may be corrected during verification by the College and may result in rejection or modification of the re-admission request.
5. The College shall verify the particulars, attendance record and examination status of every student before approving the online re-admission request through the SAMS e-Space.
6. Students are further informed that the benefit of fee waiver under the "Gyanodaya" Scheme shall be available only to those eligible students except Self Financing Courses who maintain the prescribed minimum 75% classroom attendance. Students who fail to maintain the required attendance shall become ineligible to receive the remaining benefits under the Scheme. In such cases, the balance re-admission fee, if any, shall be borne by the concerned student.
7. Readmission Fees of Students admitted in Self Financing Courses shall continue to be collected as per the existing procedure. However, the students have to apply for readmission via SAMS portal following the above procedure.
8. The online re-admission module shall remain available from 05.08.2026 (04:00 PM) to 31.08.2026 (11:45 PM). Students are advised to complete the re-admission process well before the last date to avoid inconvenience.

All concerned students are directed to comply with these instructions without fail.
